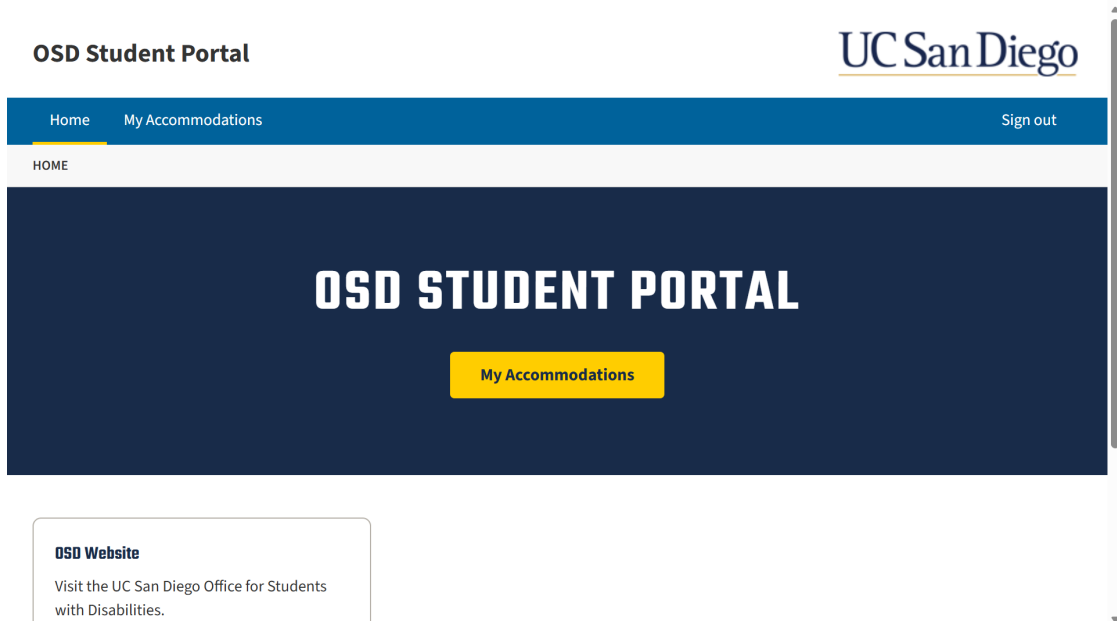


How to access the OSD Student Portal 2.0 and accept accommodations

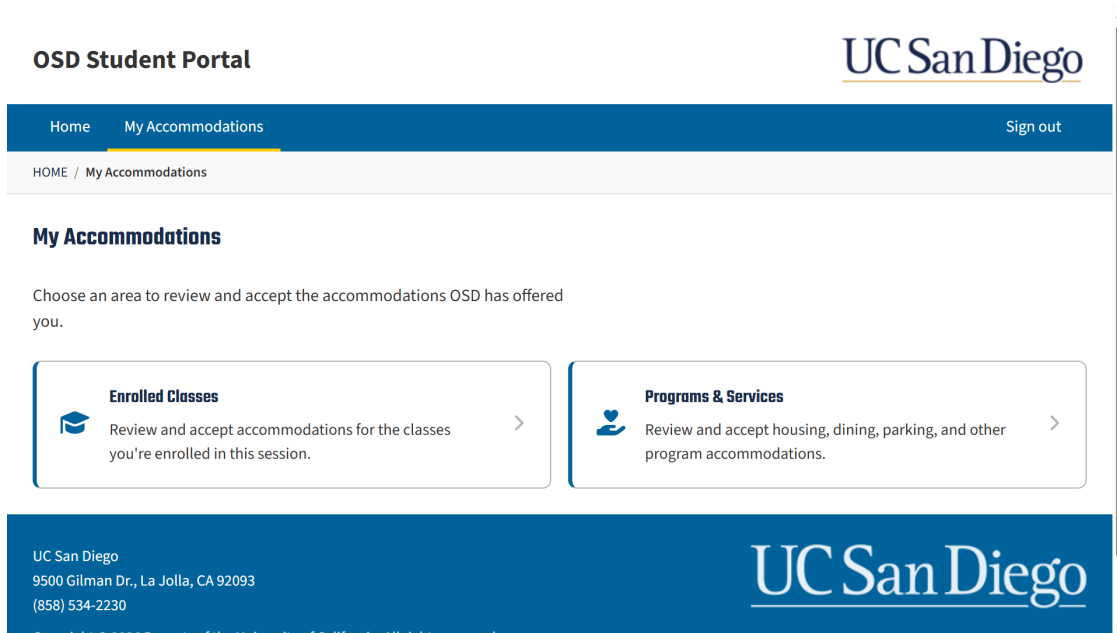
Log in to the OSD Student Portal here: <https://sisapps.ucsd.edu/myosd/student/>

Sign on using Single Sign-On.

Step #1: Click on the yellow “My Accommodations” box in the middle of the screen.



Step #2: Next click on “Enrolled Classes” in bold on the left-hand side of the screen in the middle.



Step #3: Select the relevant session. For example, to accept accommodations for Fall 2026, click on “Fall Quarter 2026-27” in bold on the middle left hand side of the screen.

Once you click on the “+” sign, the following statement appears, “upon form submission.” This is just a reminder that you have to click Submit for that class before proceeding to the next class.

On the right hand side of each “upon form submission” statement, there is a minus (-) sign. If you do not wish to accept a particular accommodation, then click the minus (-) sign and the plus (+) sign will reappear.

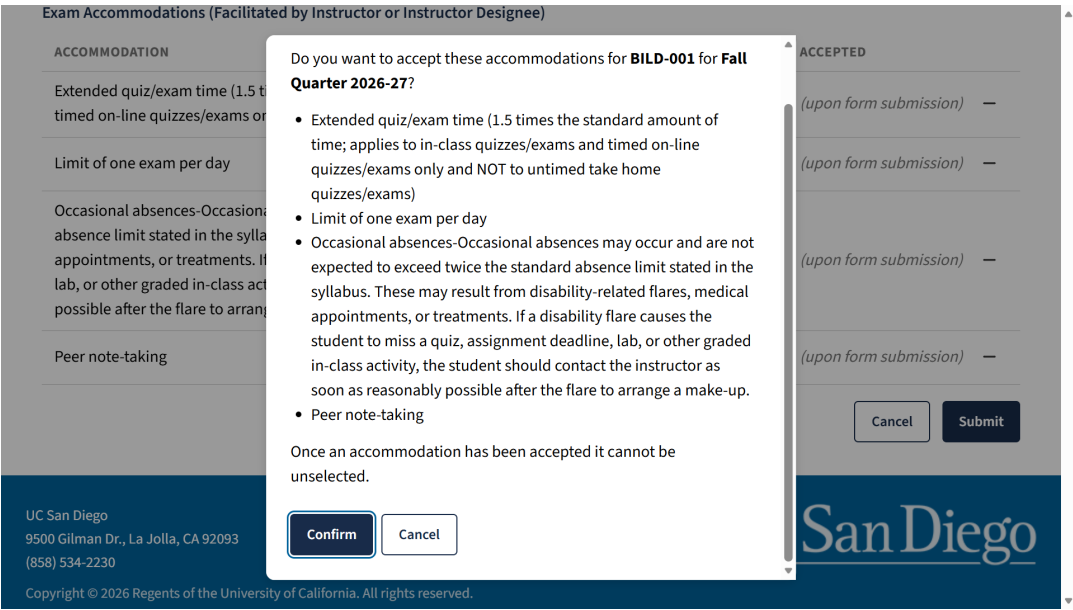

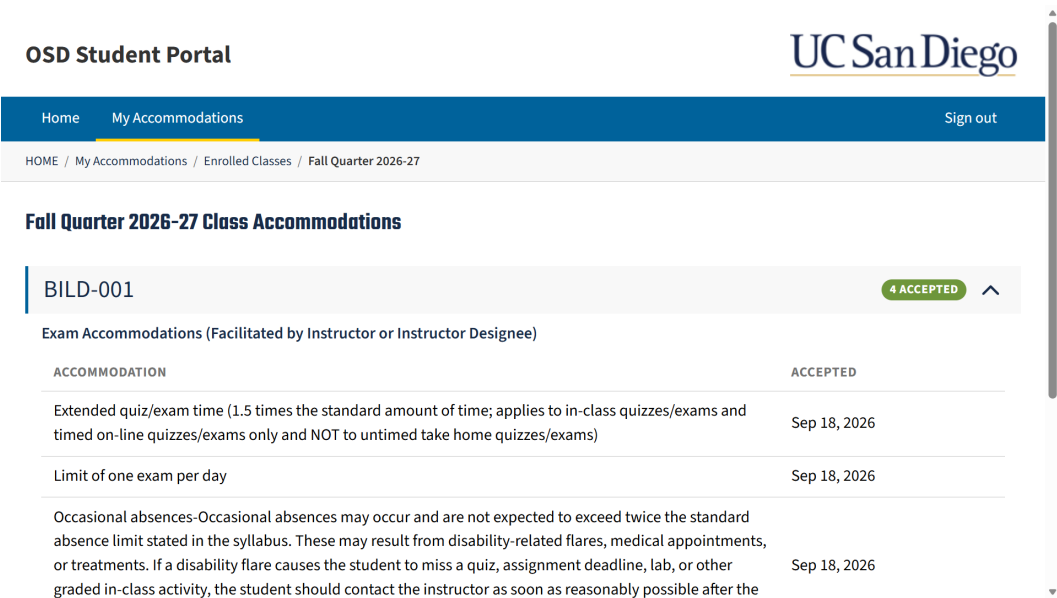

Please make sure to submit acceptances for all classes to complete the **entire** process so that the Authorization for Accommodation (AFA) letter can be sent to you, your instructor, and the OSD academic department liaison.

Step #7: Once you hit “Submit,” you will be directed to an “Accommodations Confirmation” pop up screen which asks you to confirm that you want to accept the listed accommodations for a particular class for a particular quarter. **Keep in mind that once an accommodation has been accepted, it cannot be unselected. If everything looks correct, click on the blue “Confirm” button in the lower left corner of the pop-up screen.



Step #8: A new screen appears showing that you have accepted a particular number of accommodations for a particular class and it shows the date that the accommodations were accepted. There will be a pop-up notification informing you when the AFA letters will be sent (if you have accepted your accommodations before the start of instruction).



Step #9: Repeat Steps #5-#8 for each class with accommodations.

Step #10: If you have non-academic accommodations to accept (housing, dining, parking, transportation, program modifications, priority registration, etc.), please click on “My Accommodations” on the upper left side of the blue

bar. You will be returned to the page below. Click on “Programs and Services” and follow the steps provided above to accept your non-academic accommodations.
